

When is Windows 11 coming out?

- Initial release date late 2021
- Free upgrade for Windows 10 PCs from early 2022

How much will Windows 11 cost?

- Free for eligible PCs
- New hardware pricing dependent on manufacturer

Will my current PC / laptop run Windows 11?

Microsoft has published a list of minimum hardware requirements:

- 1GHz dual-core processor
- 4GB RAM
- 64GB of storage
- UEFI, Secure Boot capable
- Trusted Platform Module (TPM) 2.0
- Graphics card compatible with DirectX 12
- Bigger than 9in display with 720p resolution
- Microsoft account + internet connection

Can I check my PC for compatibility?

1. Do you have TPM 2.0? Start by clicking in the Windows search box and typing in **tpm.msc**.
