- •New hardware pricing dependent on manufacturer

Will my current PC / laptop run Windows 11?

Microsoft has published a list of minimum hardware requirements:

- •1GHz dual-core processor
- •4GB RAM
- •64GB of storage
- •UEFI, Secure Boot capable
- •Trusted Platform Module (TPM) 2.0
- •Graphics card compatible with DirectX 12
- •Bigger than 9in display with 720p resolution
- Microsoft account + internet connection

- 1. Do you have TPM 2.0? Start by clicking in the Windows search box and typing in **tpm.msc**.
